Please provide as much notice as possible if you have to cancel or change an appointment. Ask your dentist for information about your treatment options and how much it will cost.

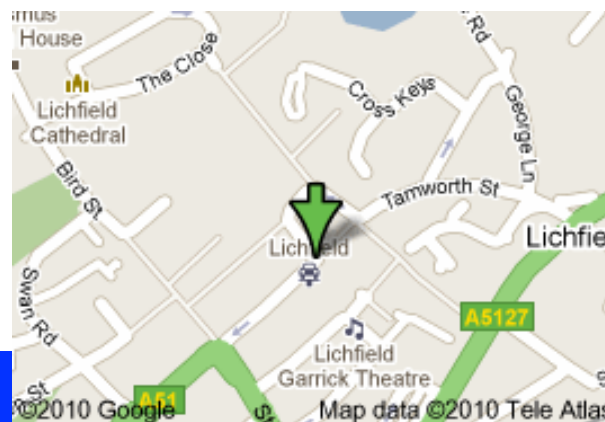
Car Parking
